Community Dinner

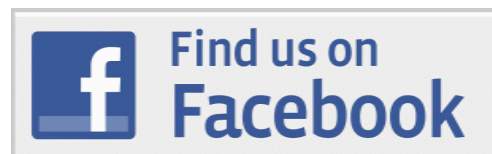
The next Community Dinner will be on July 6 from 5 until 6:30 PM and the menu will feature Mexican Chicken.
