On Saturday, September 24, we will meet at the south entrance of the school at 9:00 AM to help prepare the space by painting the curb around the flower bed, hanging a ladder and cleaning joints in the concrete and filling them

A Boy Scout has taken on the project as an Eagle Scout project so it will be his responsibility to plan and implement the transformation of this space to match the wishes of the school board and the Tecumseh North staff.

Our board voted to spend up to \$2,000 toward the project and revisit it later to see if additional funds might be warranted. The first purchase that we will make will be commercial grade umbrellas for the picnic tables.
