Ann is no stranger to our club as she has spoken to us several times about the Board of Education and her former position as State Representative, along with being a judge at our pie contests. This will be her last year on the Board of Education as she has chosen not to seek re-election. She is currently one of 10 members of the Board with each member covering 4 of the 40 Kansas Senate districts. Interestingly this carves Shawnee County into 3 different Board districts. district covers southern Shawnee County including Shawnee Heights and Auburn-Washburn. Literacy is a big concern of the Board and they funneled federal Covid money into structured literacy including \$15 million for teacher education in a program known as LETRS. Graduation requirements were changed this year by adding STEM, computer science and financial literacy. There is also even more emphasis on career and technical education including some school districts offering career paths in high school including teaching, agriculture, etc. The teacher shortage is a real problem and is being addressed by restricted licenses for those who have experience in a subject but do not have a teaching degree and teacher apprentice programs.
